Payment must be made before closing date to ensure entry into the draw

Conditions of Entry

- 1. The Regatta will be held in accordance with the British Rowing Regulations and in accordance with the Rules of Racing.
- 2. Entry fees: £10 per seat, coxes free. Entries must be made through British Rowing Online Entry and all fees must be paid by the close of entries on the 23rd May 2024. No refunds of entries will be given after the draw is made.
- 3. If sufficient entries are received for an event, they may be split into two or more bands based on Crew Ranking Index with the aim of fair and equal racing.
- 4. If insufficient entries are received for a Masters event, crews of different age categories may be raced together using the handicap system. Please enter the age category the crew is eligible to race.
- 5. Doubling up is permitted between divisions but no doubling up of any competitor or cox in the same division. Boats and blades may be doubled up in divisions as long as provisions are made by clubs in case both boats are required to race at the same time. The organisers are not able to alter race times on the day.
- 6. A minimum of three entries from two different clubs are required for an event to be held two at the committee's discretion. If insufficient entries are received, the entries will be placed in the next age category or senior event for the type of boat unless clearly indicated with the entry, or the change may lead to timetable difficulties.
- 7. If the entries received exceed the capacity of the Regatta, BROE may be suspended early. We reserve the right to exclude the following from the draw: unpaid entries, entries in events not meeting the minimum entry requirement or entries for which the Committee feel it appropriate for any other reason.
- 8. The Regatta reserves the right to limit the number of entries in an event, cancel an event or shorten the Regatta course for safety or practical reasons giving as much notice as possible.
- 9. The draw will take place on Sunday 26th May 2024 and will appear online at https://www.hexhamrc.co.uk/hexham-regatta/ Tuesday 28th May 2024 or shortly after. Competitor safety instructions will be available online alongside the draw.
- 10. In the event of the Regatta being cancelled by the Organising Committee, the Organising Committee will endeavour to refund entry fees paid once unavoidable costs have been covered. In the event of a partial cancellation of the Regatta or for events withdrawn, no refunds will be made.
- 11. Times of divisions are provisional and subject to change dependant on entries received.
- 12. EasyRegatta app can be downloaded to show live results and progression of crews into the next round.
