Entries accepted only via BROE. Entries will open 6pm Sunday 3rd May 2026 and close 6pm Thursday 28th May 2026, but may be suspended if capacity reached.

Entry Fee: £12 per seat, Coxes Free.

Conditions of Entry

1. The Regatta will be held in accordance with British Rowing Rules of Racing, relevant British Rowing Regulations, local rules and RowSafe Guidance.
2. Entry fees: £12 per seat, coxes free. Entries must be made through BROE with all fees paid by the close of entries on the 28th May 2026 to be accepted into the draw. No refunds of entries will be given after the draw is made.
3. If sufficient entries are received for an event, they will be split into two or more bands based upon the crew's Ranking Index to promote competitive inclusive racing.
4. If sufficient entries are received for a Masters event, they will be split into two or more bands based upon the crew's Ranking Index. If insufficient entries are received for a Masters event then crews of different age categories will be raced together using the handicap system. Please enter the age category in which the crew wish to compete.
5. Doubling up is permitted between divisions but no doubling up of any competitor or cox in the same division. Boats and blades may be doubled up in divisions as long as provisions are made by clubs in case both boats are required to race at the same time. The organisers are not able to alter race times on the day.
6. A minimum of three entries from two different clubs is required for an event to be held - two at the committee's discretion. If insufficient entries are received, the entries will be placed in the next age category or senior event for the type of boat unless clearly indicated with the entry, or the change may lead to timetabling difficulties.
7. The Organising Committee reserves the right to limit entries to particular events or to the regatta as a whole. Places for single, double and pairs crews in particular are expected to be limited. Clubs entering more than one crew in the same event must use crew A/B/C options on BROE with crew A being the first crew to be placed in the draw.
8. The draw will take place on Sunday 31st May 2026 and will appear on the event website shortly after. Competitor safety instructions will be available online alongside the draw.
9. Times of divisions are provisional and subject to change dependent upon entries received.
10. In the event of the regatta being cancelled, the committee will endeavour to refund entry fees paid once unavoidable costs have been covered. In the event of a partial cancellation or for events withdrawn, no refunds will be made.
11. The Organising Committee will consider all safety aspects on the day and if required alter the events or the course.
12. EasyRegatta app can be downloaded to show live results and progression of crews into the next round.
